## **Assistant Christian County Attorney Adams honored by state's prosecutors**

Assistant Christian County Attorney John Lindsey Adams was honored for his work in Christian County during the Kentucky County Attorneys Association's (KCAA) Winter Conference in Lexington on Feb. 21.

Adams received the KCAA 2008 Assistant County Attorney of the Year Award, which recognizes assistant county attorneys who provide exemplary service to their counties, according to KCAA Awards Chairperson Jennifer Hutchison-Corbin.

"Our committee was impressed with how creatively and efficiently Mr. Adams handles the various courts in Christian County," Hutchison-Corbin said. "We also appreciate the fact that Mr. Adams is a true team player who has the right balance of aggressive prosecution of criminals and compassion for the victims often caught in the middle."

Hutchison-Corbin said the fact that Adams's work does not stop at the office, but extends to his community and beyond, also influenced the committee's selection. Adams coordinates Christian County's Justice Day, chairs the Growing Up Safe Committee,

develops training programs for law enforcement personnel, presents an identity theft prevention program, and has assisted in the development of a driving under the influence prosecution manual that was distributed to county attorneys across the state.

Adams said he was honored to be named Assistant County Attorney of the Year.

“It is an honor to be recognized by the KCAA. County Attorneys work at so many different levels of state and local government and in so many capacities. I believe that the KCAA mission statement, ‘... standing for community, safety and justice,’ is a wonderful description of what this office means.
